IMPACT TEAMS

If you are approached by a member of one of our 5 Core Ministry Teams to serve on a short term "Impact Team" project, please be prepared to accept or decline the invitation as you more clearly understand your obligation as printed below from our constitution, and after you ask any questions or share any concerns:

The Organization of our church has been operating as a "Ministry Team" concept since 2014 when we discontinued operating as a "Church Board". This newer Brethren concept of organization has been very successful at First Church. We currently have 5 Core Ministry Teams. Each Core Ministry Team oversees it's certain area of ministry; planning accordingly in accordance with the mission and vision of our congregation.

The Leadership Team and/or a Core Ministry Team may constitute or authorize temporary "Impact Teams" to carry out specific assignments which are consistent with a stated mission or vision statement of our congregation. Each Impact Team shall be composed of a Team Chair and a minimum of two others. Impact Team Chairs shall call their own members or may ask for assistance from a Core Ministry Team. Non-church members may serve on Impact Teams. Impact Teams shall meet as needed. For teams that function short term, when their specific project is completed, the team shall be dismissed. The number of Impact Teams shall vary and will be based on the identified core functions of our congregation.
