### **CWS Emergency Clean-Up Buckets Sent Out**

Church World Service (CWS) released four shipments in response to Hurricane Helene, from the Material Resources warehouses at the Brethren Service Center in New Windsor, Md. The Church of the Brethren's Material Resources staff packed and prepared the shipments, which are going now to the Florida communities of Starke, Chipley, Tampa, and Wimauma. The shipments include Hygiene Kits, toothpaste, and Clean-up Buckets, with cleaning supplies. Clean-up Buckets were also sent out after Hurricane Francine. The supply is getting low. Individuals and group can make up more CWS kits following guidelines at cwskits.org
