LT Exec Team met with the 3 Coordinators. Annual contracts were reviewed and updated. There will be no SS on 12-29-24.

HOSPITALITY & COMMUNICATIONS TEAM

75 children attended the recent parking lot Trunk or Treat. There will be no 5th Sunday meal on 12-29-24. A new Gifts & Talents Survey will be available to the congregation beginning 11-10-24.

WORSHIP TEAM

The two artificial Christmas trees will be put in place before Advent. The new choir loft chairs are in transit. Blue Christmas service will be part of worship on 12-22-24.

MISSIONS & SERVICE TEAM

2024 White Gift Offering will be divided as follows: 1/3 to local outreach; 1/3 to district support; 1/3 to the denominational emergency support fund. The Giving Tree during Advent will be used to collect food donations for the local food banks. \$1000 of M&S Team 2024 budgeted money was used for the RS Ministerium's' "Seed Program" that took place earlier this year.

FINANCE & FACILITY TEAM

All the building's exterior doors are rekeyed to the same key now. An elevator emergency phone number listing should be in place soon inside the elevator. The Daycare is reviewing their current contract renewal. Discussion held on the importance of the congregation being reminded periodically of the value of consistent and intentional financial giving and tithing.

DEACON'S REPORT

Deacon calling in process. The church office has been updated with a new church membership list so it should be more accurate for the 2025 Church Directory. January will hold a new deacon's installation and recognitions for deacon emeritus.

PASTOR'S REPORT

Pastor Dave's laptop recently crashed; he thanked Bryce Nooyen and F&F for the new replacement!

Both Bible studies continue to grow in number. Discussion was held on the importance of the pastor's weekly day off and vacation time.



Killers of the Flower Moon by David Grann

In the 1920s, the richest people per capita in the world were members of the Osage Nation in Oklahoma. After oil was discovered beneath their land, the Osage rode in chauffeured automobiles, built mansions, and sent their children to study in Europe.

Then, one by one, the Osage began to be killed off. The family of an Osage woman, Mollie Burkhart, became a prime target. One of her relatives was shot. Another was poisoned. And this was just the beginning, as more and more Osage were dying under mysterious circumstances, and many of those who dared to investigate the killings were themselves murdered.

As the death toll rose, the newly created FBI took up the case, and the young director, J. Edgar Hoover, turned to a former Texas Ranger named Tom White to try to unravel the mystery. White put together an undercover team, including a Native American agent who infiltrated the region, and together with the Osage began to expose one of the most chilling conspiracies in American history.
