Church Roof Replacement Update:
The Finance and Facility Team is excited to share some great news! With the approval of the Leadership Team, we have signed an agreement with Champion Roofing to replace the entire church roof for a cost of \$122,200. This includes all

the flat roof sections as well as the shingles, and we're also replacing the skylight above the choir loft.

The project is scheduled for May and is expected to take about two weeks to complete. Because part of the new roof requires a special adhesive to bond to the concrete decking, weather conditions could affect the exact start date. We'll keep the congregation updated if any changes occur.

So far, we have raised \$97,324 toward the roof fund. Additional project costs will include permit fees, temporary disconnection and reconnection of three exterior air conditioning units, as well as repairs to drywall and carpet once the roofing work is complete. The F&F Team is currently seeking quotes for drywall repair. If you have contractor recommendations, please share them with any member of the team.

We are deeply grateful to everyone who has supported this project through their gifts, talents, and financial contributions. Your faithfulness continues to bless our church family, and the work God is doing here.
